

The Labourer card is only for those carrying out Labouring duties on site and shows employers that the holder is not on a recognised trade related pathway.

From February 1st 2025 anyone wishing to renew their Labourer card must provide evidence they are employed as a Labourer.

Operatives who continue in a labouring role can renew their card for five years by providing evidence they are either currently employed or will be employed as a labourer. This can be done in one of the following ways:

- Completion of this form. Any incomplete forms will not be processed and could mean the application is rejected.
- A signed letter from an employer on company-headed paper confirming the individual is employed or will be employed in a labouring capacity.
- For those self-employed, a signed letter from a main contractor confirming the individual is employed or will be employed in a labouring capacity.

What is a Labouring role?

A construction labourer performs manual labour on construction sites to assist with the building, repairing and cleaning of structures and sites.
