

# Replacing a Gold Supervisor card issued under Industry Accreditation

# STEP 2: Register for S/NVQ route suitable for experienced Supervisors

You DO NOT need to attend college, but you will need to <u>find a provider</u> that can undertake your assessment which can be achieved <u>using various routes including a professional discussion</u>.

Your provider will guide you on anything you need to provide to complete the assessment.

# STEP 3: Complete your S/NVQ route suitable for experienced Supervisors

The length of time to completion of the S/NVQ will depend on your experience, the evidence you have to hand, and the type of assessment method, so ensure you register for your assessment as soon as possible.

If your Industry Accreditation card expires before you have completed your S/NVQ you can apply for a temporary **Experienced Technical, Supervisor or Manager card**.



# **STEP 4: Apply for your CSCS Card**

Online applications are quick, easy, secure and open 24 hours a day all year.

# **STEP 5: Claim a CITB grant**
